On 07-12-2022, highest scorers in SSLC and PUC students were felicitated.



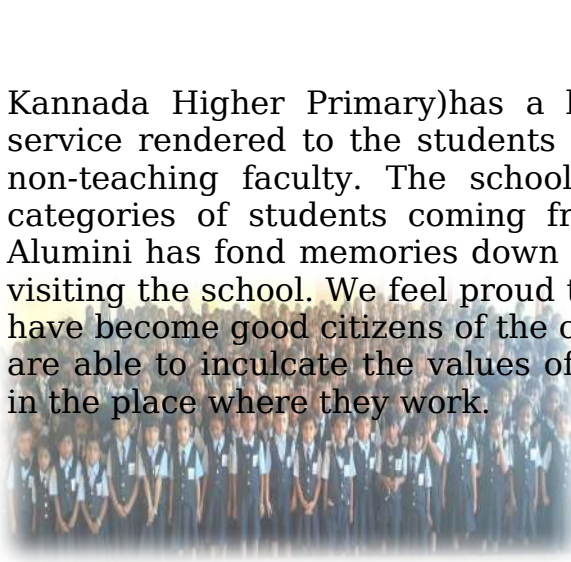
CULTURALS : Students come out with zeal and enthusiasm when they participate in cultural events.
