every child look and feel special.



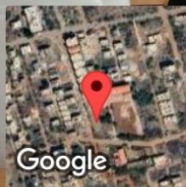

### **“Environmental Day” 5/6/2025**

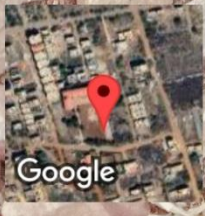

### **"Parents Meet" 11/6/2025**

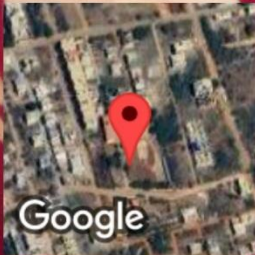

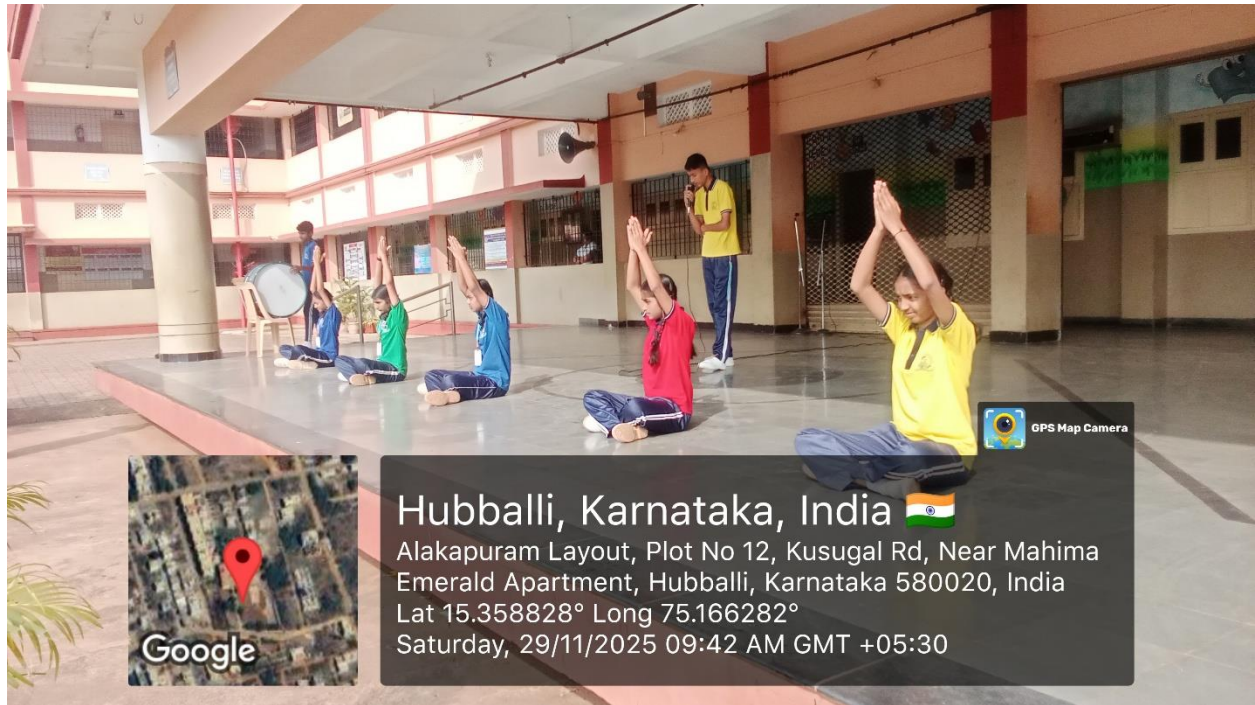






**“International Yoga Day” 21/6/2025**

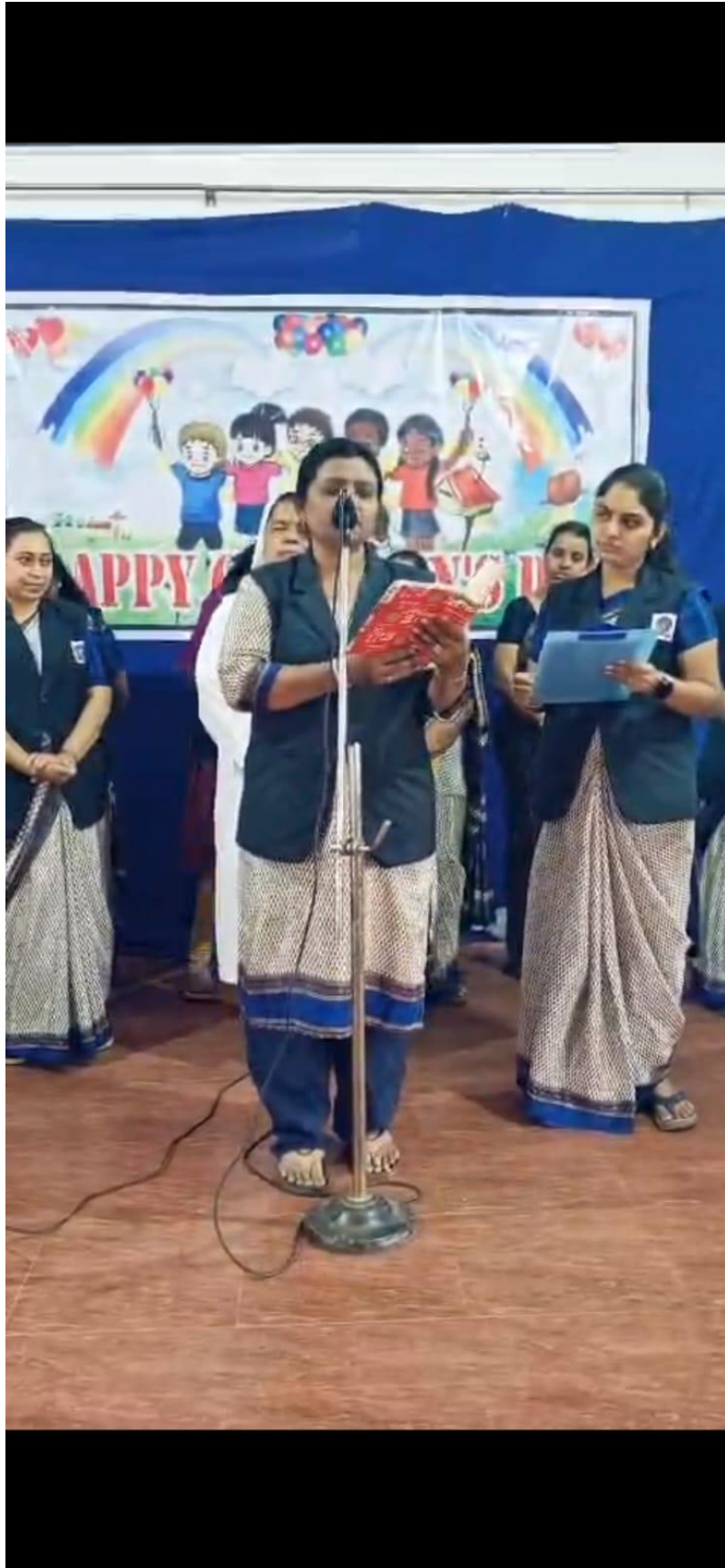

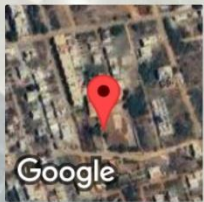
