

History:

Gulbarga Diocese Education Society is a separate entity formed by Gulbarga Diocese to carry out its Educational apostolate in the most backward and remotest places of the diocese. It was formed in 2006, after the formation of the diocese, until then, few schools and educational apostolate was carried out by the Parent Dioceses namely-Mangalore and Bellary diocese. Gulbarga Diocese Education Society shares the same Vision and Mission of the Education Commission of Gulbarga Diocese.

Vision: "Our Educational Institutions as Centres of Good News for all especially for the poor and the marginalized."

Mission: "Empowerment and Liberation of every human being especially the poor and marginalized through holistic education centred on Gospel values leading to transformation of self and society."

After incorporation of the Gulbarga Diocese Education Society (GDES), all schools run by Mangalore and Bellary Dioceses were entrusted to GDES, started with a few schools in Bhalki, Bidar, Gulbarga and Shahapur. The Society gradually extended its territory to the distant and remotest areas such as Itga, Chincholi, Kotnoor, Shahabad, Hebbala, Talikote, Santhpur, Ekamba and Aland.

- Periodic seminars and carrier guidance to help children to make right choices.
- Support for professional studies for meritorious students through other agencies also.
- Identification and selection of eligible candidates for specialized training for Competitive exams and Govt. positions.
- Impart of faith, moral, ethics and rights to all.
- Training in life skills (Job oriented skills).
- Impart of formal and non-formal education.

The changing scenario in Karnataka state and the hostile environment towards Christian institutions together with the implementation of New Education Policy, the Catholic Church is faced with enormous challenges in carrying out its Evangelization through Education Apostolate. This only further confirms the need and urgency in forming and strengthening our children with strong education and life skills so that they would become more effective, efficient and productive members of the church and society at large, with the right values and right knowledge of their rights, resulting in overall development of their villages and society.
