In today's context, fake "school program" links target school communities. We practice this by actively monitoring, warning, and educating our stakeholders. Zero tolerance for financial exploitation of our school name.

2. Programmes and Initiatives:

- Specific activities, projects, or policies implemented
Immediate WhatsApp Circular: Official scam alert notice sent to all parent/teacher groups on 2 Oct 2026
Zero fake-payment policy Clear communication that only the official school account handles fees/programs
Verification Protocol: Mandated that all payment links be cross-checked with school office before transaction
Staff Briefing*: Teachers instructed to report suspicious calls/messages claiming school affiliation

3. Impact and Outcomes:

Measurable or observable changes among students, staff, or community
Measurable*: 15+ parent groups received the warning within 2 hours of detection
Observable*: Parents now call office to verify before paying any "program fee"
Community Response*: Increased reporting of fake links to school, preventing potential losses

4. Challenges Faced:

- Practical difficulties in implementation
Speed of scammers: Fake links spread faster than official notices on WhatsApp
Parent anxiety: Some parents already subscribed before warning, causing distress
Impersonation: Scammers use school name + principal's photo, making detection hard
Follow-up: Victims hesitate to report due to shame/fear of legal trouble

5. Future Plans:

- What more the institution plans to do
Monthly Digital Safety Tips*: Add cyber fraud awareness in PTM + assembly
Official Payment Portal*: Publicize only 1 QR/UPI ID with school letterhead
Student Cyber Club*: Train senior girls to identify/report scams
Police Partnership*: Register with 1930 Cyber Helpline for faster response
